INFORMATION (Subject to Change)

AIR MAIL:

Domestic - 8c per oz. or fraction. Overseas - to or from members of Armed Services - 6c per V2 oz. or fraction.

FIRST CLASS: Written matter and mat-ter sealed sgainst inspection.

LETTERS: 3c for each oz. or frac-tion, including local delivery.

POST CARDS: (Private Mailing) 1c

POSTAL CARDS: 1c each.

FOURTH CLASS: Parcel Post covera matter weighing over 8 cz. (except lat and 2nd class). Zone rates apply.

SPECIAL MANDLING provides a means for securing same fast transit and delivery on fourth class parcels as is accorded letter mail.

If accords for any postage stamps are used, package or lefter must be endorsed: Special Handling." Additional Pee

SEALED PACKAGES

Third and fourth class matter may be closed against inspection when wrap-per bears authorized printed indicia. If sealed without indicia, parcels are sub-lect to first class rate.

SIZE OF PARCEL POST PACKAGES

Parcels must not exceed 100 inches in length and girth combined. For par-cels measuring more than 84 inches but not more than 100 inches in length and girth combined, the minimum charge shall be the rate for a 10 pound parcel. The maximum weight limit is 70 pounds to all zones.
