INSTRUCTIONS

Place one hand on the margin where the even numbers (South) or uneven (North) appear, as required for the area needed. (Fig. 1)



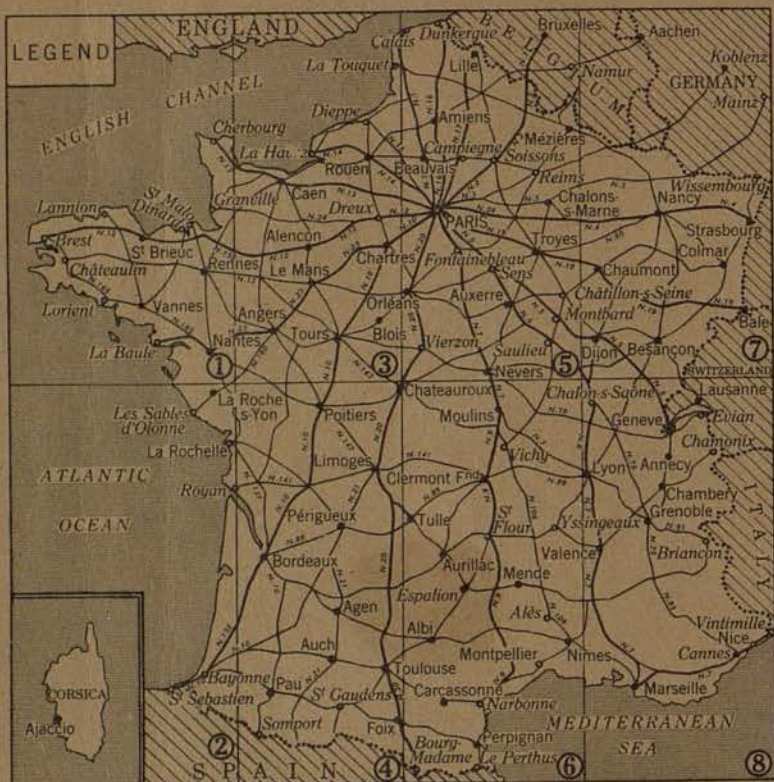

With the other hand unfold upward the overlapping portion (Fig. 2), and open the map from right to left.

To close and reopen for another section, repeat the operation in reverse and then as above.



EXAMPLES

To locate RENNES (Sect. 1) put the hand on the North border (tabs 1, 3, 5, 7) — fold the upper part upward and open to the part at tab No. 1.

To follow a route, i. e., national route 89 from LYON to BORDEAUX, move the pages from right to left.

To unfold the whole map, pull tab No. 2 to the left.

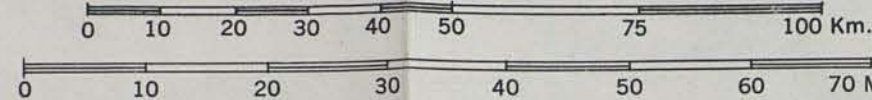
To travel from north to a south part, i. e., from LE MANS (3) to BORDEAUX (4) close 3 entirely and reopen at 4.

The North sections of the map bear odd numbers, and the South sections bear even numbers.
