See note i just received: these were printed in 1945 by hand. Many GIs came back from Europe with some of these. They were not printed in lots. To the best of my knowledge, YIVO—a Jewish organization—printed these, and considering the state of the organization at the end of the war, the pics were printed in rather primative conditions (YIVO was primarily a European based Jewish group which wanted to preserve Yiddish as a language and also wanted to preserve and document Eastern European Jewish culture; it was founded, I believe, back in the 1920s).

I believe that the negatives exist and are held at the Yad Vashem Memorial in Jerusalem, Israel. The crematorium shots are from Auschwitz and the photos of piles of bodies are from Buchenwald. Regards, Mike Hyman
