

PORTICO

THE author of these cartoons, Joaquin de Alba, known as "KIN", is a hardy and fearless fighter who uses his draughtsman's pencil as a lance against the Soviet monster.

Many of his drawings are worth the best article or pamphlet, for they condense a whole train of thought and its moral conclusion. Even when reproduced months or years after their first publication they are still up-to-date and have a historical value that is only attainable in caricature by a keen and perspicacious mind qualified to delve deeply into the inner meaning of events and the temperaments of the personages depicted.

For many years now the pencil in Kin's hands has been a knife with which he dissects Communism and those who embody it. For the benefit of non-Spanish perusers of these pages I must explain that their author was an eye-witness of the Soviet experiment carried out in one part of Spain during the civil war. He knows Communism's satanic background, the cunning and craft which it uses for its expansion, and the cruelty and barbarism which characterize its domination.

Like many thousands of Spaniards, "KIN" is also well acquainted with the doctrines of Communism, having graduated through personal experience of their application. It is therefore not surprising that he should pour out his delicate irony upon the fables and gestures of appearement and that endless chain of cowardice with which strong and powerful countries have attempted to placate the fury of the Beast, which became more implacable in proportion as consideration was greater and the remedies were more balmy.

The most interesting episodes in that process of complaisant consideration are interpreted in drawings overflowing with humour and political philosophy. Anyone who carefully examines these cartoons will end by admitting that the artist had a clearer and deeper insight into Russia and her intentions than many statesmen and

infatuated personages who proposed, by some strange alchemy, to extract good intentions from doctrines which, from their very nature, could only produce treason and crime.

All weapons are necessary in this war which threatens to develop into a universal conflagration. Communism bans all science, art, humour, philosophy, laboratory work, books, paintings, and plays that are not impregnated with its own Satanism and do not agree at the outset to deliver themselves body and soul to the absolute will of the tyrant. This means that the enemy advances along all roads and must be met and withstood wherever and under whatever shape he appears. "KIN" fights him with real ability and sureness on one of the terrains most widely used by propaganda: the cartoon.

Besides being eye-openers, these pictures tend to cause a feeling of repulsion towards the most abominable character on earth. "KIN" does not only ridicule Stalin; he presents him as he really is: the monstrous offspring of an inhuman and barbarous doctrine.

This album may be looked upon as a battery well and truly placed from the very start, whose fire contributes to the defence undertaken by a world that has awkened too late to realities and failed to save mankind in time from the Communist pest.
