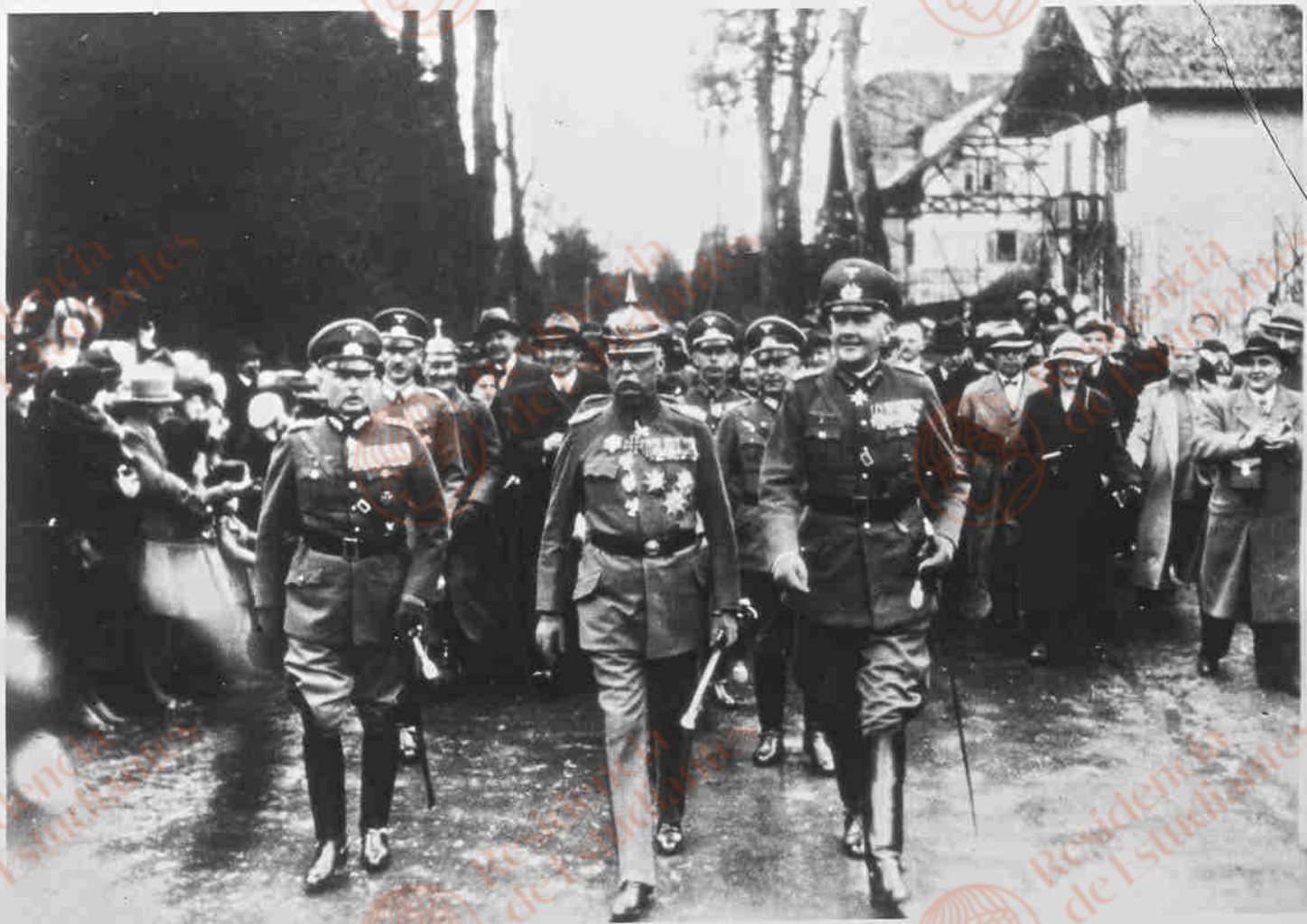

The final centralisation of the administration of German justice under Reich Minister Dr. Goertner, was celebrated with great pomp in the Prussian State Opera House at Berlin. Herr Hitler, who had returned from Berlin especially to attend, and all the other Ministers of the Reich, were present.

General Goerring in a speech said that it was necessary that National Socialist principles must be accepted by all law officials in the new Germany. Every judge must be ruled by them as Justice was a pillar of the National Socialist State.

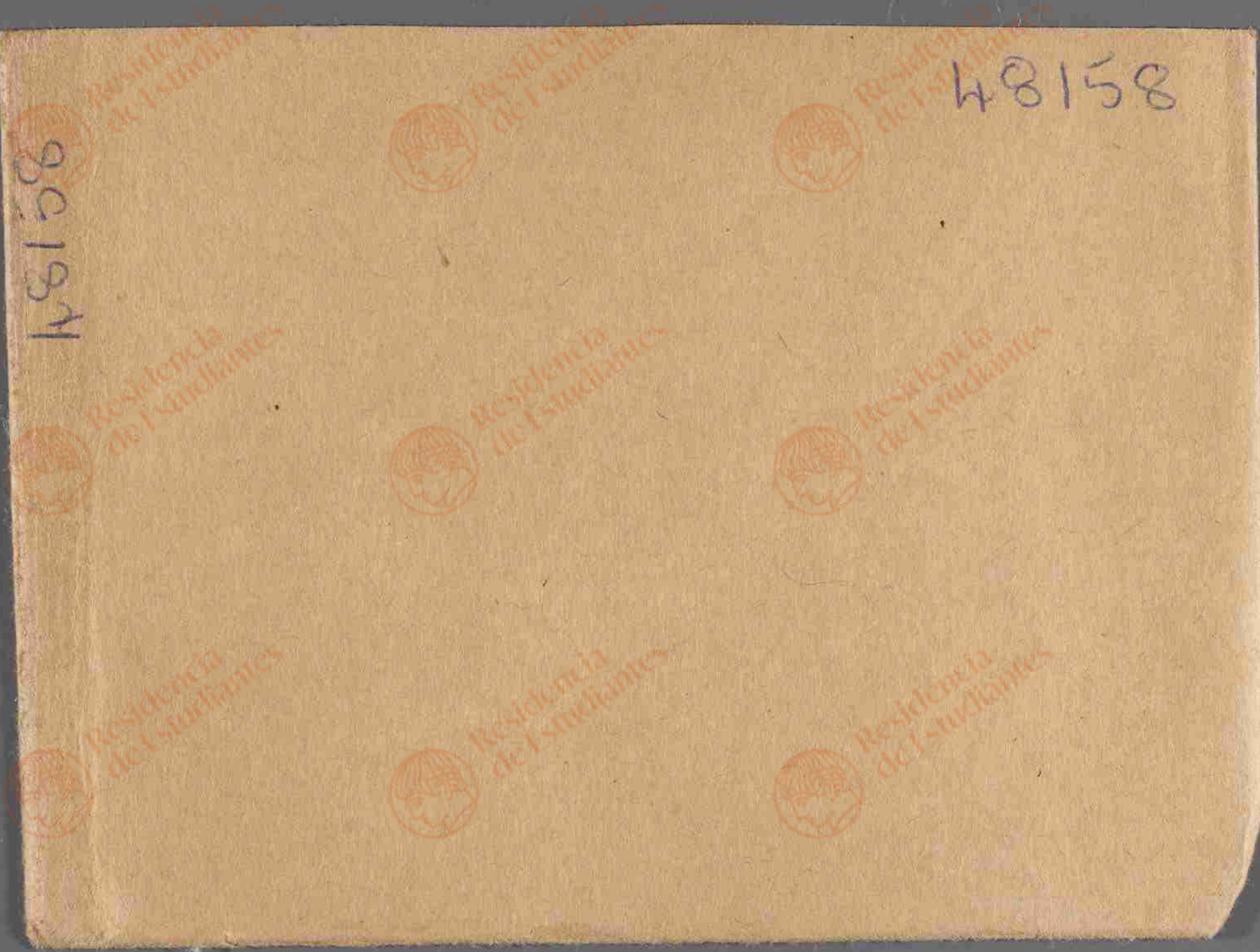
