All the fares mentioned in this brochure are payable in Sterling at the current **Travel Mark** rate of exchange and in order to comply with the regulations the following particulars must be given on booking:—

Full Name and Permanent Address.

Occupation and Nationality.

Number of Passport, date and place of issue.

Statement that you are not a resident in Germany.

Fares quoted include all meals on board.

Return Tickets are available for two months.

Travel Marks may be used on board to cover incidental expenses and refreshments.

Baggage Insurance effected at very reasonable rates.

Passports. It is essential that all passengers should be in possession of a valid Passport.

Method of Applying—British Subjects. Application for Passports on Official Passport Form, may be made by British Subjects, as follows:—

British Subjects (except those resident in the Irish Free State) to British Passport Office, 1 Queen Anne's Gate Buildings, Dartmouth St. Westminster, London S.W. 1, or to the Branch Passport Office, 36 Dale St. Liverpool.

Cost. The charge for a British Passport is 15/-d. Postal Order for this amount should accompany the application.

Visas. The attention of prospective passengers is drawn to the fact that a visa may be necessary according to current regulations in force for the countries concerned.

Rail Travel in Germany. 60% reduction on Rail Fares is allowed if tickets are booked and paid for in English Currency in advance.
