The Tzar to his brother Michael

On board the ALEXANDRIA

15th April 1895

My dear Misha,

Thank you very much for your fine letter which delighted me mostly. I was really sorry when you left, the more so as the following day we had a shooting party in Gabiouk and brought down a total of 360 pieces. Now, following your example, I walk or canoe along, with the rifle ready; one of the sailors, by yelling, manages to oust the ducks from the reeds. Since you returned to Danemark, I shot this way 14 ducks which ended up in the sailors's soup. This kind of shooting makes me very happy; I use to do it every evening before supper. The best moment is twilight. I hope that with the "old man" you manage to catch a lot of badgers and also carps. I am sure that now you are happy to stay in Danemark with lovely cousins and especially one of them. To-day, at last, we received your motor launch, but as the weather was very cool, we could not have a try and we just took a look at her from the mole. She is splendid and bigger than Sandro's, runs as rapidly and I believe you will be pleased with her. She arrived from St. Petersburg just to-day.
