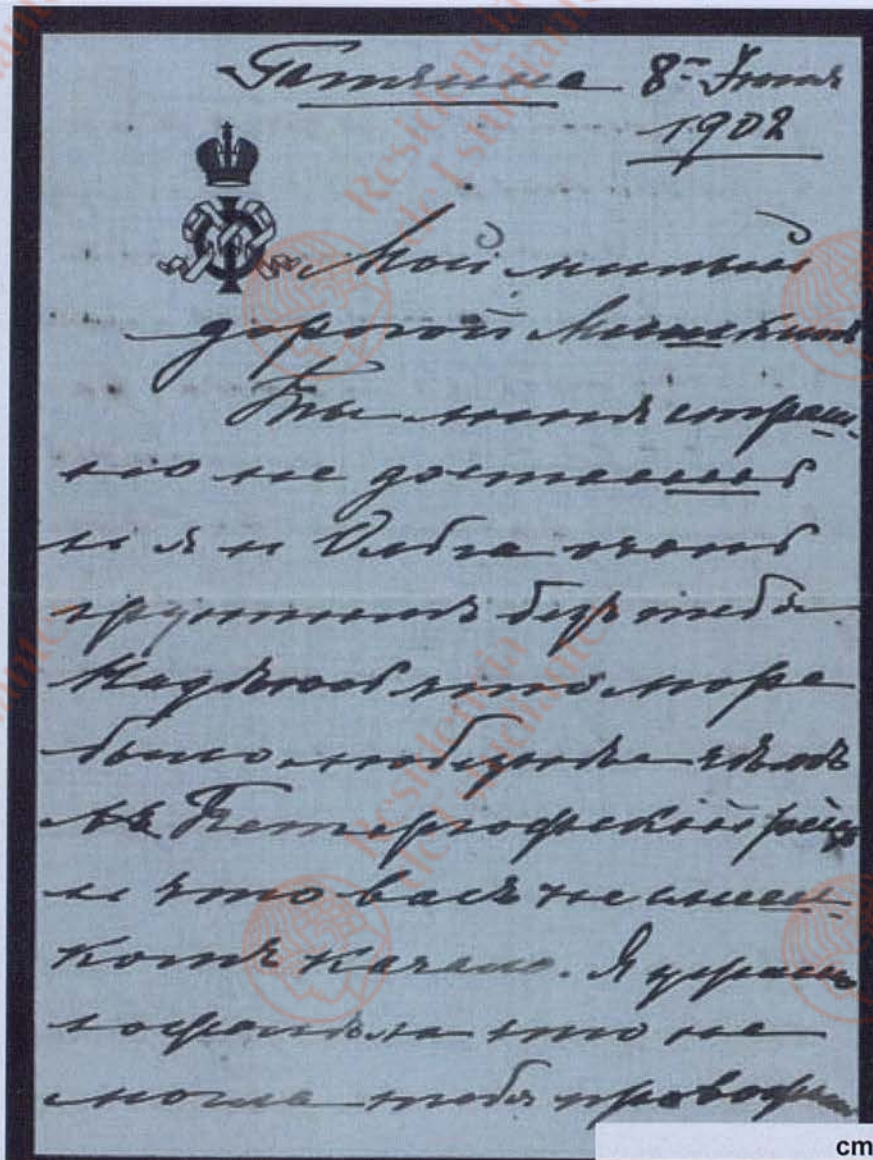

Maria Feodorovna to his son Michael

Gatchina, 8th June 1902

My dear darling Mishkin !

I miss you terribly and we have got the spleen, I and Olga, without you. I hope that the sea was milder than in Petershof's roadstead and that you were not too seasick. I was terribly sorry that I could not go with you up to Kronstadt as I wanted to, but the weather was really unattractive, so cold and nasty, "pas engageant" so that I could not say good-bye to "personne des messieurs" even to Semenov, which was very silly. After you left, we all drove to Mihaïlovskoë where we spent a long time at Tina's, playing with little Nina, who is so lovely and gay. Then had tea with Nicky and Alix and came back home at 7. All these days the weather was splendid so that we had some fishing and would have tea in the Pavilion. Yesterday, a son was born to Galitzine who received the name of Wladimir. He let me know first by telephone and then he paid me a visit, radiant with happiness. What a pity that he could not sail out with you, he is so sorry about it ! At 5.30 we had the visit of Count and Countess Vorontsov with Irina, Larka and his wife and also African. We had tea in the Pavilion and they stayed until their departure abroad at 11 p.m. Poor Count Vorontsov looks very bad, the color of his face is quite yellow, he limps and feels a great weakness. God help him to recover in Marienbad !

To-day, the weather is just hot and sultry, 19°C in the morning, but now we are having a storm and it is raining so that again we can't have lunch in the garden.

Now it is 7 p.m., we were fishing until 5. when Mary, Marussia's daughter and her husband appeared to have tea. After tea, we had a ride in the park and through the zoo "pour leur faire admirer toutes les beautés de Gatchina, les lilas, etc." And I hope that they remained very satisfied.

I am waiting impatiently to receive your telegramme from London, God help that everything be all right ! I hope that the weather improved and getting warmer in England. I envy you to be able to meet aunt Alix, uncle Fredy, Waldemar and all my nieces and nephews. If you have a free minute left, please do write, as I am so terribly anxious to know about everything, how was the passage, the meetings with everybody, how is Nicky, how the fiancé, etc... Kisses to all from me and greetings to "les messieurs" and Semenov.

I must finish now. My tenderest kisses to you my dear Mishkin. God bless you and don't forget me !
