Franco's regime was established over three decades ago. It came to power only after a 'bloody' civil war and the smashing of the political organisations and unions of the working class. Over one million workers were butchered by the Franco generals aided by Hitler and Mussolini.

Against police repression and shootings, the Spanish Working Class is once again striving to organise and form its own fighting organisations to overthrow the dictatorship of the generals and bosses.

Under the blows of the workers, the regime begins to crumble. It is to the international working class that the Spanish workers fighting the regime look for support. The SPANISH YOUNG SOCIALISTS DEFENCE CAMPAIGN intends to mobilise the strength and solidarity of the British Labour Movement behind the struggle of the Spanish workers.

In the shipyard strike at El Ferrol, at Vigo, the building workers' strike, the Asturian miners' strikes and many others, workers were shot and hundreds arrested.
