

These photos taken from an Album covering the period 1930 - 1937.

Rudi Maier was a young man, a keen footballer, who joined the Reichswehr, later to become the Wehrmacht. He was a training NCO, with recruits even before Conscription was brought in on 16th March, 1935.

Some details have been taken from inscriptions in the album, but many are fading and in the hard to dec_ipher script.

From the photographs, Rudi appears to be a serious young man who nevertheless enjoyed his army life. Although cards 18 - 45 are not commented on separately, these are a rich mine of information regarding the early German Army. What is very obvious is the very relaxed atmosphere and relations between the men & officers. They do seem to have been enjoying themselves.

How this album turned up in New Zealand is unknown. The fate of Rudi and his family remains a mystery.

Their home and sphere of activity was Saxony, with references to manoeuvres in Stadtroda - Naumberg - Bad-Kosen. He appears to have been stationed near Leipzig. It is not possible to know ... where his home was situated.
