BRITISH TANKS AND TROOPS SUPPORTED BY
GERMAN POLICE SWOOPED ON BERLIN'S BLACK
MARKET IN TIERGARTEN (JUST BEHIND THE
REICHSTAG) YESTERDAY AND ARRESTED 2,000
PERSONS, INCLUDING MORE THAN 100 RUSSIAN
OFFICERS AND MEN WHO WILL BE TURNED OVER
TO THE SOVIET MILITARY POLICE.
