with Colonel Joseph Beck, the Polish
Foreign Minister, before leaving
for the Bialowieza Forest to hunt with
President Moscicki.

much importance is attached to the
conversations which Field-Marshal Goering
is having with Polish statesmen.

It is said that Poland is now ready
to strengthen her relations with the
"axis" powers.
