NATIONALIST COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF STRIKES
AT TERUEL.

The Southern column, under General Aranda, commander-in-chief on the Teruel front, is stated to have advanced 12 miles in the big advance which the Nationalists have carried out in a surprise attack on a 25-miles front in the Teruel sector.

General Aranda's men are reported to have swept the loyalists from the heights of Palomera from where they had been launching attacks on the Saragossa road. The road, a vital means of communications, is now stated to have been made safe for the Nationalists.
