CLEARING UP BERLIN -

Scenes familiar to all Londoners in 1943 and 1944 are now just as familiar to all the people of Berlin. Dangerous buildings, damaged by Allied air raids, are being pulled down by the Royal Engineers and German women are clearing and cleaning the bricks for use in the rebuilding of shop-fronts and houses.

A recent order by the Military Government to local authorities requires them to make one room in each house waterproof for the winter.
