The Biggest allied convoy to Russia fought through a four day attack by enemy torpedo planes and U boats, to deliver her cargoes at an Arctic port. The Commodore of this convoy was Rear-Admiral E.K. Boddom-Whetham, D.S.O., and the escorting forces were under the command of Rear-Admiral R.L. Burnett, O.B.E., flying his flag in the cruiser H.M.S. Scylla (Capt. I.A.P. MacIntyre, C.B.E., R.N.)
