The foreign ministers of Germany, Italy, Hungary,  
and Czechoslovakia met at Belvedere castle in Vienna  
November 2nd 1938 to discuss the regulation of a new  
Czech-Hungarian border. According to a decision of Joachim  
von Ribbentrop, Germany's foreign minister and Italy's  
count Ciano a new frontier was outmapped and accepted  
by Czechoslovakia and Hungary.
