STALINGRAD RELIEF ARMY PUSHES ON. DON CROSSED  
AT SEVERAL POINTS.

Radio picture from Russia is most vital fighting front shows 1: Men of Marshal Timoshenko's relief army Nor-West of Stalingrad dissecting their machine gun fire at the Germans as they flew in disorder. After battering at the German flank for ten days, the relief army is making notable progress, crossing the Don at several points and establishing bridgeheads.
